

## Invest in our future

The Bridge to Hope has served homeless single mothers in the Phoenix area for over ten years.

Dedicated to promoting homeless single mothers' physical and spiritual well-being through the dignity of work. Since 2011, The Bridge to Hope has successfully provided housing to over 45 women and their children, ready to change the trajectory of their lives from homelessness to wholeness.

We do not go at this alone. In partnership with local faith communities, we provide each mother a community of belonging where they can learn their value in Christ, who emotionally and spiritually supports them through a comprehensive mentoring program. Additionally, we offer each mother the opportunity for an education and training to help equip women to excel in the workforce and support their families as a single parent.



## Invest in their future

Over the next four years, The Bridge to Hope will ask our donors to give toward Campus of Hope. To do so, we have a goal to raise \$500,00 over the next four years to purchase a property. This will position us to purchase the property when the Lord opens this door.

We will eliminate the debilitating cost of housing our Bridge mothers by opening our own property. Currently, we are leasing units from a local apartment complex at a cost close to \$1,700 per month per unit. We are also paying \$900 a month for office and program space. That is over \$9,100 per month for property rentals; for the five units we rent, the amount per year just to house our mothers is close to \$110,000. And each year, our rental costs increase.

As a volunteer with The Bridge to Hope I have seen the incredible impact that this ministry has.

Our very first mom moved in straight out of a treatment center. Her next door neighbor's did drugs. The smell spread from their apartment to hers. I remember thinking, "She will never stay sober in this complex." By God's grace, she did but the odds are stacked against them all, living so close to drug users.

These moms need a place to live in a sober environment. If The Bridge to Hope could own a property, it would be a Christ-Centered, supportive environment where they could safely sit outside and allow their children to play, enjoy cookouts, and feel safe. It would be a place where they would flourish.

Additionally, there is the issue of stewardship. In the past 8 years, the rent has doubled. We are in a situation currently where our ministry funds have to be spent to provide housing that will continue to go up in price. If we could purchase our own property, it would open up countless new opportunities while containing costs. The mothers would see the value of owning versus renting and would hopefully be motivated towards home ownership for their future.
